On The Grounds

SILVER BUTTONWOOD (CONOCARPUS ERECTUS VAR. SERICEUS)

The low-branching, multi-trunked, silver buttonwood is instantly recognizable by its unusual appearance. The Florida favorite has beautiful silvery leaves due to silky hairs which cover the leaf surface. The inconspicuous flowers of the striking evergreen tree are white, yellow or pale green and later mature into clusters of small, button-like reddish brown fruits. This plant's unusual color contrasts beautifully with all the green in a landscape. Although it is often



planted as a multi-trunked ornamental shrub, since the plant grows in a vase shape - wider at the top - the silver buttonwood is often cultivated as a tree, and can grow to a height of 50 feet. This Florida native is one tough customer and flourishes in any environment as long as the temperature is above freezing.
