<u>FOUND MONEY</u> by Charles Reith, PhD – Member of the Palmer Ranch Watershed / Natural Assets Committee



Floating in the middle of Mira Lago's lakes are vegetated islands that improve water quality and attest to the commitment of community leaders. The four islands have adorned and purified the lakes since mid-2018, when they were purchased from an east coast firm called Beemats and installed by Beautiful Ponds. Beemats were purchased through a \$7,200 grant from the Gulf of Mexico Alliance, based on a proposal by Mira Lago's then-President Carol Auricchio. Carol launched her search for funding at workshop hosted by the Sarasota County Extension Services, where speaker Mollie Holland announced that grants were available for communities that wanted to reduce nutrients in their lakes and, by extension, protect Sarasota Bay. Carol wrote a proposal to the County that was not approved, but many months later, after Hurricane Irma, read an email from Tracy Smith of the Palmer Ranch Master Association that the Gulf of Mexico Alliance was offering grant funds. Not one to give up easily, Carol put pen to paper and authored a successful proposal. Carol says the grant itself was not hard to write but that supporting paperwork – budgets, outreach plans, and all – required some pulling together. Further, the Gulf of Mexico

Alliance required more information as part of a final report with receipts, photographs, and community involvement. Carol's hard work paid off, not just landing the grant and overseeing the installation but also motivating Mira Lago to get more involved in the environmental health of its lakes, which are now managed by a Lakes Committee that Carol chairs.

(2) Providing immediate financial grants to severely combat-wounded and hospitalized Special Operations personnel and their families.


